Elevated on the third floor of a Regency townhouse, just seconds from Kemptown Seafront, this one-bedroom flat couldn't be more quintessentially 'Brighton'. The fashionable and eclectic mix of restaurants, boutique shops and wine bars of Kemp Town Village are within walking distance, as are the city centre and promenade, making this the ideal home for home seekers and investors alike.

Taking the stairs to the third floor may seem like a climb, but once inside the main reception room, the views are well worth it. It is also noticeably more peaceful up here and the natural light into the flat is gorgeous – particularly during the afternoon due to its westerly aspect.

There is ample space in here for comfortable chairs and a formal dining table by the windows so you can appreciate the sea views as you eat. Conveniently, the kitchen is adjoining the living area with simple units in white. These would benefit from updating, but this would add value to your investment.

Peacefully positioned to the rear of the building, the bedroom is a great size double room with space for a king size bed and several pieces of freestanding bedroom furniture without compromising on space. The bathroom nearby has a shower over the bath, and like the kitchen, could benefit from modernisation as the space is great allowing for a full bath suite.


